High fashion in Stage 3

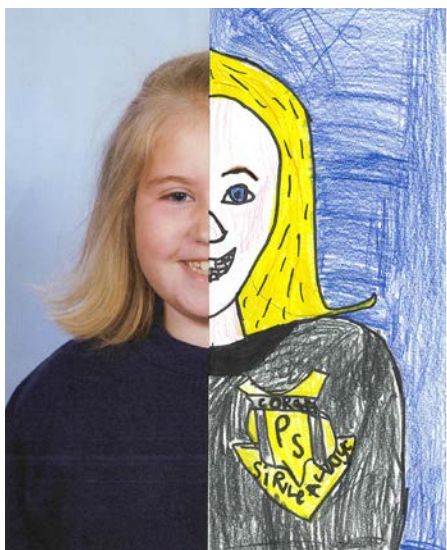
Stage 3 showed their aptitude for fashion design in STEM sessions this week when they created these lovely new uniform items using only newspaper and masking tape.





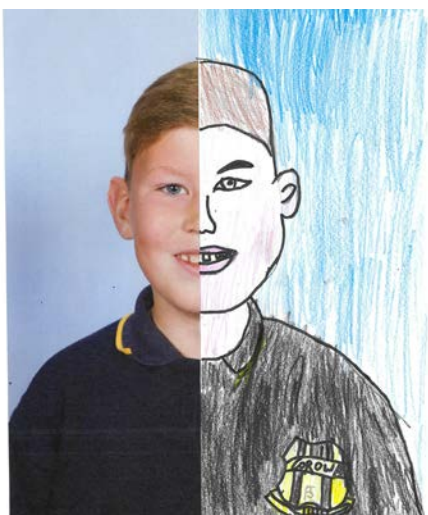
Platypus' study natural landscapes
