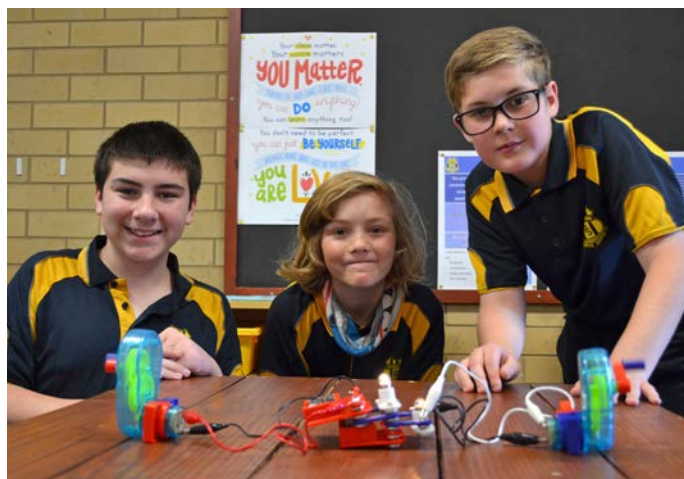


Possums work it out
